The session was conducted to enhance leadership skills and develop new skills to help meet career and organizational objectives of the students. The program provided a solid foundation for students looking to enter leadership positions. The program aimed at building on existing skills and experience and apply those skills to workplace situations. Content included communications, ethics, performance management, change management, team building, planning, and project management.

Speak to success is an initiative and student engagement program for preparing and grooming the students to develop confidence, unite them as a team and work towards a common goal, enhance public speaking skills, unleash their creative self, and help the students to have a taste of the competitive world outside.

To achieve the before said goals, the batch of students has been divided into equal groups with one team leader and a name decided by the group members.

Program will progress as follows:

- Each team will be randomly allotted a vertical from the health care industry.
- They are required to come up with an innovative idea to portray their group as a brand in the allotted vertical.
- Each group will be given 30 minutes; 10 minutes for presentation, 10 minutes for performance and 10 minutes for Q/A round and feedback.
- In a session of 2-3 hours a day, 3 teams will be taken up.
- Teams are strictly advised to abide by the time limit.
- Teams will be judged by a panel of judges (internal or external) based on idea, confidence, communication skills, question handling and overall performance.
- Three teams come to the final round and will be judged by an external panel of judges. The awards will be as follows:-
 - 1) Best Team
 - 2) Best Performer
 - 3) The Extraordinaire

Women Entrepreneurship Summit'18

An extremely inspiring summit was conducted by **Symbiosis Centre for Entrepreneurship and Innovation (SCEI)** on **27th Aug 2018** and **The Association of Women Entrepreneurs/Industrialists of Maharashtra (WIMA)**.

The session focused on the soft skills needed for becoming successful entrepreneurs.

The event started by **Dr. Vidya Yeravdekar** (Principal Director of Symbiosis Society) addressing the audience.

Then **Ms. Suchitra Kanade** (WIMA – Chairperson) addressed the audience and spoke about how WIMA is contributing towards development of social entrepreneurship, professional entrepreneurship and rebooting women’s who have taken a break from their profession.

Dr Dilip Thosar (CEO – SCEI) addressed the audience and explained the details about SCEI.

Ms Anna Roy (staff member of NITI Aayog) addressed the audience and told us how government initiatives are supporting women to make them follow their dreams.

The second segment of the summit was **an interactive session with a panel of successful entrepreneurs in which various panel members shared their success stories with the audience.**

Ms Namita Thappar (Chief Financial Officer at Emcure Pharmaceuticals Ltd) was the moderator for the panel.

Nivedita Saboo (Designer – NIFT Gold Medallist) was one of the panel member. She spoke about the path of women entrepreneurship and how a women should stop playing her women card. She also said

that a woman should never wait for anyone to give them power, they should take it because they deserve it.

Gayatri and Madhura (Hygeeias Foodsz,Founders): These two were a special panelist members as they were the alumini's of Symbiosis International University. Both of them spoke about how once upon a time as a student they had wished for a thing, about the difficulties they faced during their initial stages and how they both overcame the problems and achieved what they had wished for.

Arun Nathani(Founder and CEO of Cybage): He was the only male panelist member. He spoke about how women should keep an eye upon the opportunities that come to their way.
